Dear Friend of Our Lady,

In a world of televised and web-streamed media it would be unusual to find someone who has not heard of ISIS or Islamic attacks on Christians in various parts of the world, even among the many supporters of Our Lady's apostolate who avoid television and the internet.

Part of promoting the Message of Fatima involves making people aware of the growing dangers from the enemies of Christ, which Our Lady of Fatima warned about. Islam is one of the fastest growing of these enemies and it is the [Fatima Message](#) which provides the one and only solution to defeating them.

Over the years because of this threat, The Fatima Center has written articles advising Catholics to beware of the growing threat of Islam and reminding them of the need for the Consecration of Russia to stop the threat.

The [November 2015 letter](#) to volunteers addressed the horror of western countries opening their borders to these enemies of Christ under the false guise of helping "refugees".

We know our volunteers take their roles in spreading Our Lady's Fatima Message seriously. And spreading that message includes warning of the punishments already upon us, as well as those yet to come from Islam and others.

Our volunteers contact us to convey the difficulties experienced in trying to spread the Fatima Message, which includes spreading the truth about the enemies of Christianity.

Because of the resistance encountered by many, we are always looking for new ideas to help those who are working to spread Our Lady's Message.

Recently we came across something interesting that might help to convince those unwilling to listen or believe the truth

regarding the dangers of Islam. We have enclosed it with this letter.

It is a new leaflet entitled, [St. John Bosco on Mohammedanism](#) - another term referring to the Islamic or Muslim "religion", named after Mohammed, the man who started that false belief system.

This leaflet might be of help in trying to instruct the ignorant of the truths that the Islamic "religion" is based on, and founded in, violence right from its onset; and that the violence we read about today isn't just some small segment of an otherwise "peaceful" group of people.

And what makes this leaflet really appealing is that it is the words of a well-known and popular saint.

John Bosco was born in Italy in 1815 and was ordained to the priesthood in 1841. His life's work as a priest was working with youth, reaching out - not with physical punishment, but with kindness and charity - to young boys who were poor, outcasts and often in trouble.


He relied on the generosity of laity, raising funds in order to provide the youth with housing, food and education. After years of struggle and many setbacks, eventually the value of his work was recognized by secular authorities, which made the acquisition of funding much more accessible and led to the opening of technical schools and workshops.

From priests and teachers who desired to help him in his work with the youth, the Society of Salesians was founded. At the time of his death in 1888, there were 250 houses of the Salesian Society in all parts of the world containing 130,000 children, from which annually came 18,000 finished apprentices. Don Bosco was canonized by Pope Pius XI in 1934.
