Day 1 - Monday, May 10

Evening departure for flight to Portugal from Liberty International Airport (Newark, NJ).

Day 2 - Tuesday, May 11

Upon arrival we will travel to the hotel in Fatima for lunch and rest. Mass will be celebrated at Fatima.

We will visit the **Sanctuary**, the **Little Chapel of the Apparitions (Capelinha)**

where Our Lady appeared six different times, visit the **Old Basilica** as well as the Tombs of **Blessed Francisco** and **Blessed Jacinta**, and **Sister Lucy**. Overnight in Fatima.

Day 3 - Wednesday, May 12

We will visit **Aljustrel**, where we will find the homes of the three children, the well, **Valinhos**, where Our Lady appeared in August, 1917, the **Cabeço** where the angel appeared, **Fatima Village Church**, and the **Cemetery**. After dinner we will take part in the **Candlelight Vigil Procession** at the Fatima Shrine. Overnight in Fatima.

Day 4 - Thursday, May 13

In the morning we will have early Mass and then proceed to the Shrine to see and pray for the Holy Father as he presides over the 10:00 AM Mass. After, we will travel to the magnificent **Cathedral of Our Lady of Victory in Batalha** with its beautiful monastery and renowned chapels. Overnight in Fatima.

Day 5 - Friday, May 14

Today we will visit **Santarem**, site of the **Eucharistic Miracle of the Bleeding Host**. From there we will travel to Lisbon and visit the **Birthplace of St. Anthony**. We will also visit **Jeronimos Monastery**, perhaps the most prominent monastery in Lisbon, and the **Madre de Deus Church**, one of the most beautiful churches in the world. Overnight in Fatima.

Day 6 - Saturday, May 15

Short Fatima Pilgrimage ends. Following breakfast in Fatima, pilgrims on the short pilgrimage will depart for the airport for their flight home to Newark, New Jersey.

Day 6 - Extended Pilgrimage Continues to Portugal and Spain

Following breakfast in Fatima, pilgrims travel to **Tuy, Spain**, stopping at **Viana do Costello**, the **Shrine of Saint Lucia**, patron saint of eye problems. We will visit the **Convent in Tuy**, where Sister Lucy received the vision of Our Lady and the Holy Trinity requesting the Consecration of Russia, and where she wrote the words

Our Lady spoke in the Third Secret. Overnight in Tuy.

Day 7 - Sunday, May 16

We will have Mass. After Mass, we will travel to **Pontevedra** where Our Lady and the Child Jesus appeared and spoke to Sister Lucy of Fatima. We will walk in the footsteps of the Child Jesus, and see the cell where Our Lady appeared with Her Son asking for the **Communion of Reparation on the First Saturdays**. Then proceed to **Rianjo** where Jesus prophesied to Sister Lucy the

danger of death facing the Pope and our bishops today because Russia has not been consecrated to the Immaculate Heart. Overnight in Tuy.

Day 8 - Monday, May 17

We will travel to **Santiago**, the **third most visited pilgrim site in all of Christendom**, where we will visit the **Tomb of St. James the Apostle** in the magnificent 1000-year-old cathedral. Overnight in Tuy.

Day 9 - Tuesday, May 18

After Mass we return to Fatima driving through pastoral scenery. We will stop near the **City of Porto** where Our Lord appeared to **Alexandrina**. Overnight in Fatima.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS - All pilgrims must have appropriate travel documentation i.e. valid passport and/or visa procurement. Please send to Servants of Jesus and Mary a photocopy of the page in your passport with your picture on it 90 days or more before departure.

IMMUNIZATION – Check with your local Health Department and/or doctor.

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENTS – A deposit of \$500.00 U.S. per person and a completed reservation form are required to secure a reservation. Reservations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. Telephone reservations may be made by Visa or MasterCard payment of the deposit; a completed reservation form must be mailed. Full payment is required no later than 90 days prior to departure. Payment received less than 90 days prior to departure is subject to a \$50.00 fee. Payment may be made by check, money order, Visa or MasterCard. NOTE: Checks may not be accepted less than 90 days prior to departure unless certified.

ROOMS – Prices are based on double occupancy. Where double rooms are not available, accommodation will be in triple rooms, with no reduction of price. Single rooms are available in some hotels at a supplementary cost. Ask for details when you make your reservations.

TIPPING – Tips and gratuities are at the discretion of the pilgrim and are not included.

BAGGAGE – Baggage is subject to airline regulations. What follows is our best understanding of those regulations: Each pilgrim may check two bags, with maximum weight of 50 lbs. and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. One carry-on with maximum dimensions of eight inches by 20 inches is also permitted. Luggage is the responsibility of the pilgrim and the airlines, not the organizers. Claims for lost or damaged luggage must be made through the airlines or other carriers by the pilgrim.

CANCELLATIONS – If you cancel more than 60 days prior to departure, you are entitled to a refund of all monies paid to date of cancellation less \$150.00. (This includes a \$30.00 non-refundable handling fee.) If you cancel 60 days to 29 days before departure, you are entitled to a refund of all monies paid to date of cancellation less \$150.00 and less any penalties applied by (but not limited to) the airlines and hotels. (This also includes the \$30.00 non-refundable handling fee.) There is no refund if canceled four weeks or less prior to departure. Cancellations must be in writing. Date of postmark prevails. Insurance for cancellation is available from the travel agent. The organizers are not responsible for this insurance.

ORGANIZERS' RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY – The organizers reserve the right to decline or accept or retain any persons as a pilgrim participant, to make changes in itinerary necessary for the comfort, convenience and safety of the pilgrim participants, and to cancel the pilgrimage at any time. If the organizers cancel the pilgrimage, it shall have no responsibility beyond the refund of the monies paid to the organizers by the pilgrim participant.

The organizers are responsible for making arrangements for all pilgrimage facilities and services described in the brochure and reservation form. If for any reason such facilities and services cannot be supplied exactly as described, the organizers may substitute comparable facilities and services. Any additional expenses incurred are the responsibility of the pilgrim participant.

The organizers will use their best efforts to ensure the comfort and safety of participants, as long as they are with the pilgrimage group, however, the organizers will not otherwise be liable for participants' safety and well-being. Furthermore, the organizers are not liable for the safety and well-being of any participant who is separated from the pilgrimage group whether voluntarily or not. Health and accident insurance are the responsibility of the pilgrim participant. The pilgrim participant agrees that the organizers shall **not** be liable for any damage or loss (including personal injury, death and property loss) or expense occasioned by any act or omission of any persons, including suppliers of services, or for any act of war, insurrection, revolt, or other civil uprising, military action, strike, or act of God occurring in either country of origin, through passage, or destination.

The airlines, hotels and land operators and other suppliers providing services are independent contractors and not agents, employees, or associates of the organizers. The organizers assume no responsibility or liability in connection with the service or any aircraft, motor coach, taxi, or other conveyance which may be used in the performance of its duty to passengers. All vouchers and other documents for services issued by such independent contractors and/or the organizers are subject to the terms and conditions specified thereon and to the laws of the country where services are supplied.

The organizers are not responsible for any domestic travel arrangements. **Pilgrim participants must arrange connecting flights or other travel arrangements so as to arrive at the departure point in time to join the pilgrim flight.** In the event of failure of such arrangements, however caused, participants may join the pilgrimage, however, the organizers are not responsible for any additional expenses of participants in doing so.

All rates are based on current currency exchange rates, current fares, and pre-established minimum number of passengers traveling, and rates are subject to change.

TRAVEL INSURANCE PROTECTION PLAN - For your own protection, we require that all pilgrims provide proof of a minimum level of Travel Insurance. Servants of Jesus and Mary can arrange for suitable insurance coverage for a nominal fee. Please ask organizers for details.
